



Chelsom create custom lighting scheme for a new hotel in New York, The Beekman.

hompson Hotels have recently opened a new hotel, The Beekman. This new hotel is located within the centre of Lower Manhatten district, between the East and Hudson rivers. The hotel is surrounded by cherished attractions which include the Brooklyn Bridge and the World Trade Centre.

The lighting for this new hotel is a stunning custom design and has been created by Chelsom, working closely with Martin Brudnizki Design Studio and the Cardy Group.

It is completely individual in its entirety as to be expected from MBDS. The lighting pieces designed for the project were no exception. Some of the key pieces include Art Deco themed bespoke ceiling pendants in antique brass and frosted glass with laser cut detailing. These are situated in the entrance lobbies to the hotel suites. There are also stunning mouth-blown smoke glass chandeliers adorning the other guest rooms and suites. They have bespoke orb ceramic table

lamps in an olive green crackled finish complete with decorative collar, as specified for the bedside along with a kitsch foo dog table lamp in imperial blue.

There is a striking desk lamp in the form of mouth-blown Venetian glass hand-painted egg in a plethora of vivid colours. The guest rooms also have two floor lamps; One has a fantastic metal fitting and is finished in matt black with a decorative wooden handle teamed with a peacock blue French drum shade lined in gold, giving a warm ambient light and creating a subtle shimmer effect. The other has more of a retro feel, in the form of an angle poised metal floor standard with a solid marble base and brass detailing finished with a coloured can shaped head.

All of the bathrooms have a duo of vintage inspired chrome wall sconces positioned either side of a centrepiece mirror. The lights are all dimmable LED's which are encased in moulded optical frosted glass, creating a classic yet eclectic feel,





perfectly in-keeping with both the flawless interior scheme created by the team at MBDS and the historic building itself.
