and functionality.

Stylish white LED 'Motion' desk lamps perfectly blend the latest design with efficiency, the rectangular top am swivel section projects powerful LED reading light downwards while sophisticated met black tapered trumpet 'Milano' floor standards teamed with black cotton shades provide supplementary ambient lighting, complementing the distinguished colour pelette of sharp neutrals, greys and blacks beautifully.
